## Fundraiser Agreement

1. The Fundraiser is organising the following fundraising activity ("the Event"):

2. The Event will raise funds for the IPF.

- a. All funds raised will be donated to the RFU Injured Players Foundation
- b. If costs are to be deducted from funds raised, this must first be agreed with the IPF
- c. The proceeds of the Event must be passed to IPF within 2 months of the Event date

3. The IPF will licence to the Fundraiser (until the close of the Event) the IPF trade mark (number 2562072) and the right to use the IPF name and charity number for use solely during and to promote the Event provided that:

- a. Materials using the trade mark, name or charity number are approved in advance by IPF
- b. All such uses comply with the guidelines provided by the IPF
- c. Such licence will expire at the close of the Event

4. The Fundraiser will comply with charity law regarding disclosure of fundraising statements and disclosure of registered charity numbers and with all other applicable law and regulation in relation to the Event, including but not limited to:

- a. Not doing anything to bring IPF into disrepute
- b. Not carrying out house-to-house collections
- c. Not collecting in any public place without first obtaining a collector's licence from the appropriate local authority (usually the police or the council)
- d. Not collecting on private property (including shops, pubs etc) without first obtaining the permission of the owner
- e. Making sure the Event, and any third parties involved are fully insured and do not take unnecessary personal risks

5. The Fundraiser acknowledges that the IPF cannot take responsibility for any losses made through the Event or liability arising from the Event

6. The Fundraiser will inform IPF at the earliest possible opportunity if they have to withdraw from or cancel the Event due to injury or other circumstances

7. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, English law. Each party irrevocably submits for all purposes in connection with this agreement to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts
